



## **LLMHA COVID-19 SAFETY PLAN – EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 30, 2021**

Referring to the Provincial Health Order, "Gathering and Events", September 18, 2021, the requirement for proof of vaccination is now in place for game-days. Logan Lake Minor Hockey Association ("LLMHA") works with the District of Logan Lake to design our guidelines for arena use. We are continually monitoring the latest BC public health orders and, as such, all guidelines below are subject to change. Our arena usage guidelines are as follows:

### **Practices**

- Proof of vaccination NOT required.
- Spectator group size is limited to a maximum 50.
- Spectators are parents and family watching from the stands; this does not include volunteers, players, coaches, bench staff, team managers and safety person.
- Masks are mandatory for players except field of play which is defined as the bench and ice.
- Recommended 2 metres of physical distancing.
- No spitting anywhere in the arena.
- No entry to anyone showing signs or symptoms of COVID-19 (e.g. cough, fever, soar throat).
- Covid-19 Health Check required for each player before play.
- All water bottles to be clearly labelled.
- U7, U9, U11 players are to arrive fully dressed.
- Parents are not allowed in change rooms.
- Team volunteers can assist with tying up skates.
- U13 and U18 players may use changerooms.

### **Games and Tournaments**

- Proof of vaccination **IS** required by all those entrants over 12 years of age on game day.
- Players, coaches, bench staff, team managers and safety reps are exempt from vaccine requirements.
- Players and coaches will be permitted to enter the arena 30 minutes before the start of the game.
- Masks are mandatory for individuals 12 years of age and older except field of play which is defined as the bench and ice.
- Recommended 2 metres of physical distancing.
- No spitting anywhere in arena.
- No entry to anyone showing signs or symptoms of Covid-19 (e.g. cough, fever, soar throat).



- Covid-19 Health Check required for each player before play.
- All water bottles to be clearly labelled.
- U7, U9, U11 players should arrive fully dressed when possible.
- Parents are not allowed in change rooms.
- Team volunteers can assist with tying up skates.
- U13 and U18 players may use changerooms.
